- 3. All activities are to be requested for approval, in person, at a general membership meeting of the Club unless otherwise approved by the Board of Officers
- 4. There will be two individuals of the User group identified as responsible persons who are responsible for the activity; one responsible person must be a club member
- 5. The user agrees to compensate in full for any and all damages to the clubhouse buildings and grounds, inclusive. A Reservoir Riders board member will inspect the facilities prior to the activity and after use to determine any damages and that the facilities have been left in an acceptable condition. The responsible person(s) may accompany either inspection
- 6. All trash and garbage generated during the activity are to be removed immediately from the buildings and grounds.
- 7. Open fires will be allowed only at designated locations. The clubhouse fireplace is not to be used without prior permission and without adequate instructions in its proper use
- 8. Smoking is not allowed in any Club buildings
- 9. A \$75.00 deposit is required prior to the date of use and will be refunded if the above conditions are met.
